

It costs about £85,000 a year (say £7,000 a month) to continue with our ministry at St Jude-on-the-Hill.

Most of this income is provided by the generous and dedicated gifts of the regular members of our church family.

It helps enormously if your financial circumstances allow you to commit to making a regular gift to God's work.

We realise that people's circumstances do change, for better or worse, and that you may need to change your commitment at any time.

We normally ask our members to review their commitments to us once a year.

Many people find that the simplest way of making regular donations is through a Bank Standing Order.

If you are a UK taxpayer, making a Gift Aid Declaration enables us to increase the value of your gift by 28% at no extra cost to yourself.

The Church of England challenges every church member to give a regular proportion of their income to and through their local church. It encourages us all to aim to give 5% of our take-home income after tax and NI.

This way we all share the burden of paying for the church's ministry fairly,

according to the blessings God has provided to us individually.
